### Inclusive Education Class for Students with Severe Disabilities

This class was developed to meet the needs of elementary level students who could benefit from a fully included environment, yet required significant instructional support due to their disabilities. These students are generally moved to this program from other EDCOE classes for students with severe disabilities. The students are integrated into general education classes for most if not all of their school day. They work on modified academic tasks in the standard general education curriculum with support from inclusion aides. They also have some individual and small group time in their special education classroom to work on specific IEP goals related to functional academics and life skills.

Students eligible for placement in this program exhibit one or more of the following characteristics over a long period of time, to a marked degree, and which adversely effect educational performance:

- a. an inability to learn that is not explained by intellectual;
- b. an inability to build or maintain satisfactory interpersonal relationships with peers and teachers;
- c. inappropriate behaviors or feelings under normal circumstances exhibited in several environments;
- d. a general pervasive mood of unhappiness or depression; and/or
- e. a tendency to develop physical symptom rears associated with personal or school problems

These classes are highly structured to meet the needs of this unique population and are not appropriate for students diagnosed the social maladjustment or conduct disorders.
