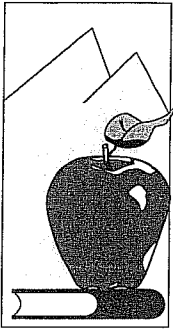

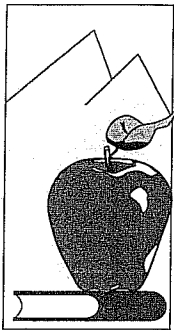

Thank you very much for your donation of a Kettler adapted trike to the El Dorado County Office of Education. The students in the Special Services Preschool class at Schnell School will benefit greatly from your donation.

The foot strap system on the trike allows the students with motor impairments who might not otherwise be able to keep their feet on the pedals of a bike to participate in bike riding with their peers on the playground. The trike also has an upright handle so that an adult can help power the bike out of the student's view. This allows the student to develop the "motor memory" necessary to pedal with just enough adult help to foster success and independence.
