**BP 5240 Student Health Care and Emergencies**

The Board recognizes the importance of taking appropriate action whenever an accident or illness threatens the health, safety, or welfare of a student. To facilitate immediate contact with parents and guardians, the Board requires that the following information be provided, and kept current, for each student:

1. Home address and telephone number
2. Parent/guardian's business address and telephone number
3. Name, address, and telephone number for a person who is authorized to care for the student in case the parent or guardian cannot be reached
4. Physician's phone number and medical insurance record number

Students being released for health care and emergencies must be checked out at the school office by the parent/guardian or designee. No student will be released from school for the purpose of obtaining confidential medical services without the consent of the parent or guardian.
