

INSTRUCTION

BP 6320 Curriculum Development

The County Board encourages development of district curriculum above the general minimums required by the State of California. The Board shall annually adopt a basic educational program as described in the El Dorado County Course of Study. The County Board also encourages the development of a K-12 coordinated curriculum in accordance with SEEK-12 standards to facilitate matriculation between schools and grade levels. The enrichment and/or extension of the program at the local level is the responsibility of the governing board in each district required to use Board adoptions.

For Juvenile Hall class students, the Board approves the inclusion in the instructional program, instruction in (1) all areas of health education; and (2) survival skills, in accordance with existing legal requirements.
