

INSTRUCTION

BP 6330 Community Day School

California Education Code Sections 48660 et seq. provide for the establishment of one or more community day schools by either a school district governing board or county board of education.

The El Dorado County Office of Education has established community day schools located regionally to respond to county needs.

Students meeting the requirements of Education Code Section 48915(d) and referred from school districts in El Dorado County may be assigned to a community day school program if he/she meets one or more of the following conditions as specified in Education Code Section 48662:

1. The student is expelled for any reason;
2. The student is probation-referred pursuant to Sections 300 and 602 of the Welfare and Institutions Code;
3. The student is referred to a community day school by a school attendance review board or other referral process;

First priority for assignment to a county community day school shall be given to students expelled pursuant to subdivision (d) of Section 48915; second priority shall be given to students expelled for any other reasons; and third priority shall be given to all other students.
