

INSTRUCTION

Regional Occupational Program

El Dorado Union High, Black Oak Mine Unified, and Lake Tahoe Union School Districts requested that the County Office contract with the Central Sierra ROP to provide business and program management services starting in 1995-96.

The Deputy/Associate Superintendent for Instructional Services and Student Programs and the Deputy Superintendent for Administrative Services oversee these services. A director from the El Dorado County Office of Education oversees all compliance phases of this program.

The County ROP programs shall provide a curriculum which includes skill training in occupational fields having current and future needs for such training. The program will provide an opportunity for students to acquire technical and occupational skills which may lead to a combination work/study schedule, upgrading vocational skills, and retraining where necessary. In addition, the program will prepare students for enrollment in more advanced training, enter into post-secondary and tech-prep programs.
