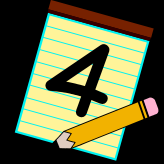
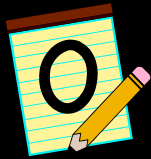

El Dorado County Office of Education Public School Facts 2010-2011

- There are 58 County Offices of Education in California. 53 County Superintendents are Elected, 5 are appointed.
- The primary role of a COE is to:
 - Act as an Intermediate Education Unit
 - Provide Student Programs and Services
 - Coordination and Collaboration Convener
 - Public Education Advocate

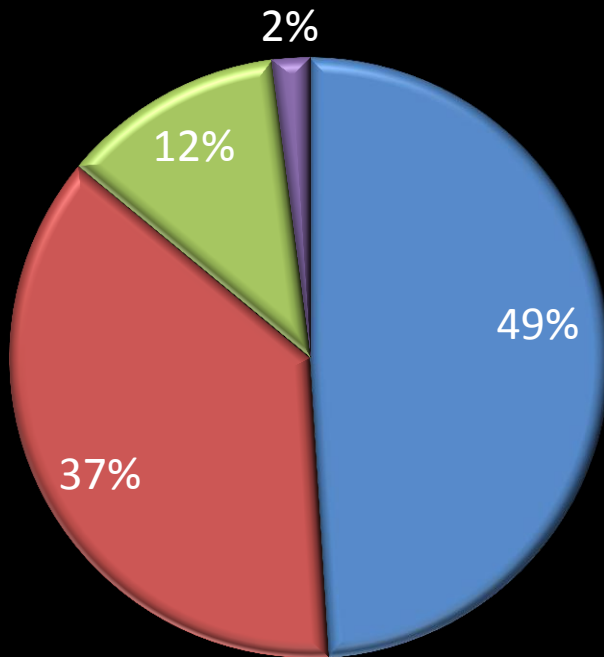
El Dorado County API School Ranking

The schools are then sorted from lowest to highest statewide

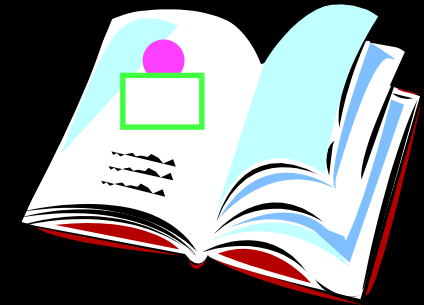
The schools are then divided into 10 equal groups

CAHSEE Combined (Grades 10-12) Results 2007-2010



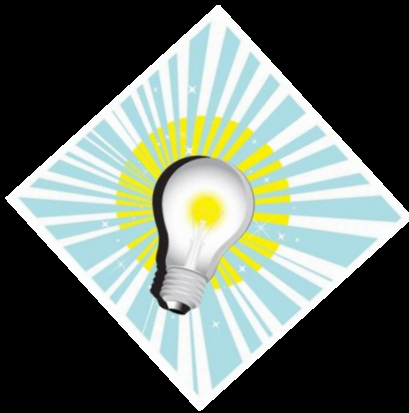

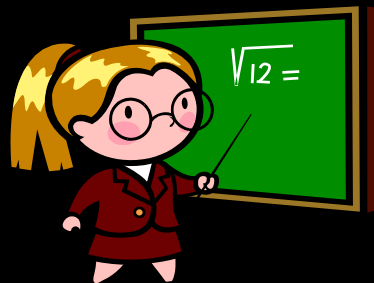

County Enrollment by Ethnicity

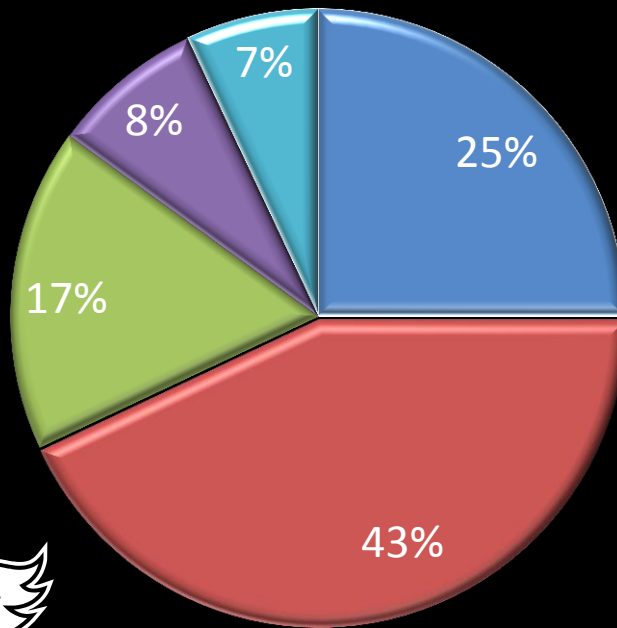
- African American 2.0%
